FAQ FOR 2025 WORLD BLOOD DONOR DAY

Pre-Event

1. Event Details:

- Date: 28 June 2025, Saturday
- Venue: Marina Bay Sands Expo & Convention Centre Basement 2, Hall D and Hall E
- Timing: Award Ceremony (10am 12pm), Registration starts at 9am, Hall D
 Carnival (10am 6pm), Hall E
 Community Blood Drive (11am 5pm), Hall D
- Event graced by Minister for Health, Mr. Ong Ye Kung
- There will be no afternoon Ceremony for Silver and Bronze
 - Award Ceremony 10am to 12pm, Registration starts at 9am (Hall D)
 - All donor milestones awards including Blood Champion (Gold and Merit) and Adopt a Bloodbank awards (except Silver and Bronze) will be presented in the morning
 - Award recipients can collect their Silver and Bronze Awards at the booths set up outside Hall E. They will receive an invitation email sent by our appointed events management company. To collect the award, the recipients will need to show the email at the collection booths.
- Each award recipient can only be accompanied by 1 guest for the Ceremony
 - Should award recipient enquire about bringing a toddler, we will recommend him/her to make caregiving arrangements where the caregiver + toddler can visit the carnival while the Ceremony commences
- There will also be a carnival happening concurrently in Hall E and donors are welcomed to bring their family to join the carnival

2. How do an Award Recipient RSVP for the awards ceremony?

All Award recipients who have achieved the milestones as of 31 Dec 2024 would receive an invitation email to WBDD 2025. The invitation email will be sent by our appointed event management company.

- A. Award recipients may follow the instructions on the email to RSVP
 - a. Recipient will receive an email and they can click on the RSVP icon to register
 - b. Follow the instructions on the microsite to RSVP

- B. Award recipients may call in to request SRC's assistance to register for the event. The following information is required.
 - Name
 - Email address
 - Award serial no. (e.g. G0001 for Gold award, R0001 for Ruby award) this can be found on the top right-hand corner of the physical invitation letter and invitation email
 - Is the Award recipient bringing 1 guest? Each award recipient can only be accompanied by 1 guest for the Ceremony

3. What happens on 28 June WBDD after the awards recipients have RSVP?

There will be 2 queues for the Award recipients who have RSVP.

One for those with QR code (registered with email address) and the other one for those without QR code (without email address).

A. Award recipients Who RSVP with Email Address:

- Award recipients who RSVP via the registration link (in the email sent by the appointed events management company), would receive an unique QR code in their confirmation email for actual day registration.
- Award recipients proceed to the Registration Counter outside Hall E for registration using the unique QR code (in confirmation email) on 28 June to register their attendance for the Ceremony. The award recipient will receive a printed event badge and red wristband. The guest will receive a yellow wristband.

B. Award recipients Who RSVP without Email Address:

 Award recipients will have to bring the physical invitation letter for registration at the Assisted Registration Counter outside Hall E on 28 June. The award recipient will receive a printed event badge and red wristband. The guest will receive a yellow wristband.

4. What happens if Award Recipients are unable to attend / reach on time for the ceremonies?

The awards ceremony will start on time. Awards recipients are advised to be seated 15 minutes before the awards ceremony. Those who are not seated before the start of the awards ceremony (9.45am) will not be able to receive their awards on the day.

- Award Recipients who are unable to attend / miss the awards ceremony can email to donate.blood@redcross.sg to request for collection.
- Medallions and certificates will be ready for collection approximately 1 to 2 weeks after 28 June 2025.


- If the Award recipients are unable to attend the ceremony on 28 June to receive their awards, they are able to assign someone (a proxy) to collect the awards on their behalf (proxy collection).
 - Award recipient to send an email to donate.blood@redcross.sg to inform us on his/her request.
 - The proxy should show the email (from Award Recipients on the proxy collection request) to us for verification and let us know the awardee's name and award serial number.
 - The proxy collection can take place on event day 28 June at basement 2 outside Hall E.
 - If the proxy collection is on event day 28 June at MBS, the collection timing is between 10.30am - 5pm.
- If the Award recipients are unable to attend the ceremony on 28 June to receive their awards, they are able to assign someone (a proxy) to receive the award on stage on their behalf.
 - Please advise the Award recipient to send an email to donate.blood@redcross.sg to inform us on his/her request.
 - Please advise the Award recipient to RSVP via the invitation email they have received.

1. Is WBDD a ticketed event?

2. Is the ceremony and carnival open to the public?

Bronze and silver will collect their medallions from 10.30am to 5.00pm outside Hall E and are eligible to participate in the carnival too.

Carnival is for invited donors only (10am to 6pm).

3. How many carnival cards will be issued?

1 carnival card, 1 blind bag pen, tissue packs are issued for 1 invitation (email or SMS) only

4. What is the colour of wristbands on that day?

Red is for award recipients and yellow is for guests. General donors will be given blue wristbands.

5. Mode of entry to carnival?

The invited guests have to flash their email invitation or SMS at the carnival registration counter.

6. Can the awardees go over to the carnival after the ceremony?

Yes.

7. Does the mobile blood drive accept walk-ins?

No, it is an appointment-based basis.

8. Can the guests re-enter the carnival?

Yes, as long as they have the wristbands on.
